



COTAG-Moray Safety Policy Statement

- 1) COTAG–Moray is committed to ensure that all its activities will be carried out without injury to personnel or public and without damage to equipment or property.
- 2) COTAG–Moray will endeavour to minimise the effect on the environment by its activities.
- 3) COTAG–Moray agrees to identify and assess all risks associated with its activities and to ensure suitable control measures are in place to lower the level of risk to As Low as Reasonably Practicable (ALARP) which will allow these activities to be carried out safely.
- 4) COTAG–Moray agrees to ensure that all operational members shall receive suitable and sufficient training to allow them to carry out duties which may be required by the group.
- 5) COTAG–Moray will investigate any incident or accident which occurs involving group members or members of the public or any other body during its activities. Any equipment or vehicle damage will also be investigated in an effort to prevent recurrence.
- 6) COTAG–Moray expects that all members of the group who are engaged in its activities to exercise responsibility and care in the prevention of injury and ill health to themselves and to others who may be affected by their actions.
- 7) COTAG–Moray will conduct annual audits to ensure compliance with the above.
- 8) Overall responsibility will fall on the Committee to ensure that COTAG meets its commitment as laid out above.
- 9) A committee member will be appointed to take responsibility for all Safety and Environmental issues (Appendix vii)
